Parent & Child Phonics Workshops – Summer Term

We will be continuing to run a series of workshops around phonics for **ALL** Year R/1/2 parents during the Summer Term. These workshops are designed to support parents with the expectations for reading in the Early Years and Key Stage 1.

We appreciate that some parents may not be able to attend sessions due to working commitments and other circumstances. Please do remember that Grandparents and extended family are more than welcome to come along to work with your child in school. We have also heard success stories where groups of parents are working together to 'rotate' attendance at sessions between them and working with a 'group' of children in the sessions, so that all children feel represented.

If you are not available to attend the sessions or to send a representative, you are welcome to ask your child's class teacher for a copy of the questions to match each book or to enquire about the art activity, should you wish to replicate this at home.

Additionally, there are 'seasonal' activities for each phase that are regularly updated, such as handwriting, wordsearches and match the picture/word activities.
