To mark the King's Coronation, we will be taking part in "The Big Help Out," an initiative designed to get everybody involved in supporting their local community and being active within it!

We will be having our "Big Help Out" on **Tuesday 23rd May.**

Year 5 will be going to Farringford Court, to read stories to residents. They will be escorted by school staff, via minibus.

Year 4 & Year 6 will be going to Belmore Lodge, again to read stories to residents. They will walk to Belmore Lodge, escorted by school staff.

Year 3 will be visiting Little Orchards Nursery, to read stories to the children. They will walk to Little Orchards, escorted by school staff.

Year R, 1 and 2 would like to invite Grandparents or other special grown-ups in to school to play some traditional games in class together, such as dominoes, tiddlywinks and card games. This event will take place from 10.45am to midday. Please note, that we can only accommodate 1 grown up per child.

The event for Years R, 1 and 2 **is a bookable event – each grown-up that attends will need a ticket, which can be obtained from the office. Names of visiting grown-ups need to be recorded with the school office in advance.** This allows us to appropriately organise the event and safeguard our children. Pupils are welcome to bring in board games of their own too, should they so wish, but please label the box!

As you have signed the local area forms, a permission slip is not required for any of these community initiatives, however, if you do not want your child to take part, please let the school office know in advance. Packed lunches are not required, all children will eat in school, as normal.
